



CAMPUSES






Our campuses are situated in key maritime precincts in Durban and Cape Town

Our campuses are well-positioned for easy access for all learners. They are in the hub of both Durban and Cape Town.

The Rope Shed is located at **6 Timeball Boulevard, Signal Road, The Point, Durban**. Established in the 19th century, it is a well-preserved building and a relic from the days of sailing ships when rope replacements were constantly needed. It is here in Durban that learners are first introduced to the maritime culture.

31 Victoria Road, Woodstock, Cape Town. Located near the Castle of Good Hope, the campus is in the centre of the urban renewal area of Woodstock. The rejuvenation of old buildings and the revitalisation of accommodation, shops, and restuarants, has led to Woodstock being firmly back on the map. The building was formerly a bank stronghold and is perfectly engineered to ensure a valuable fortress for our learners.







Yacht Hand (Competent Crew)

Introduction to the boating world, enabling you to become a competent crew member aboard a sailing or power driven vessel. Course content includes nautical terminology, boat handling, knots and basic seamanship.



On successful completion of the Day Skipper course, you will be entitled to skipper a vessel over nine meters in length, within 15NM of your home port. It is a starting point to a career within the sailing industry.

Coastal Skipper

On successful completion of this course you will be entitled to skipper a vessel anywhere, but within 50NM of the coast.

Yacht Master Offshore

On successful completion of your Coastal Skipper and the logging of the required 2800NM, the next step for you is the Yacht Master Offshore. Once completed you are allowed to skipper a yacht on any ocean passage.



Short Range Certificate radio courses (SRC)

SAMSA Marine Notice 4 of 2016 requires all current and new Restricted Radio-telephone Operator Certificate holders to convert to the updated Short Range Certificate (SRC).

We are an accredited service provider of SAMSA offering courses for both new and conversion operators (VHF licence holders will be exposed to DSC/GMDSS functions).

NOTE: Enquire about our classes, to be held during working hours, evenings, or both.















Learner's Licence

This licence is required before learning to drive, equipping you for on-the-road training with an instructor or licensed driver. Training includes:

- Rules of the road
- Vehicle controls
- K53 driving test
- Understanding traffic, signs, signals and road markings
- Defensive driving
- Classroom sessions
- Simulated tests
- Study material



Driver's Licence

After obtaining a Learner's Licence, driver training may begin. All training is provided by our fully qualified instructor. Our vehicles will also be available for hire on test day and the instructor will accompany the learner. We cover the following areas:

- Pre-trip inspection (interior & exterior)
- Alley Docking
- Parallel parking
- Three point turn
- Open road driving

- Practical skills, handling and packaging techniques
- Registered skills certificate on completion (US 242974)
