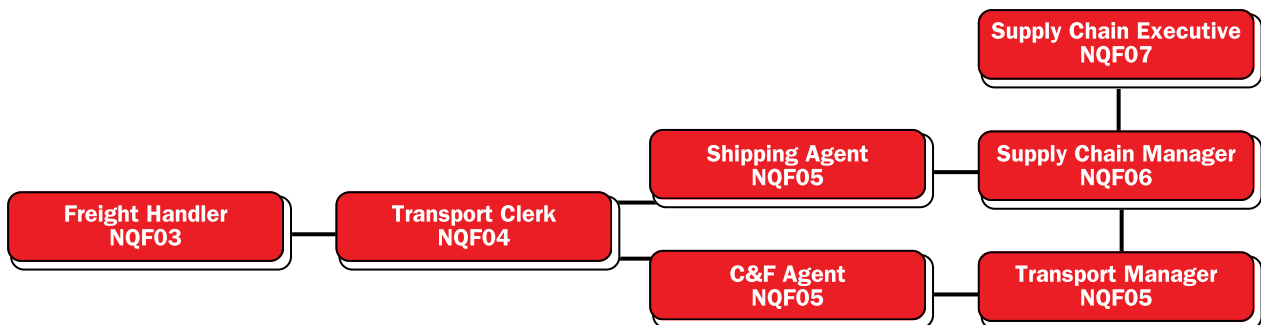

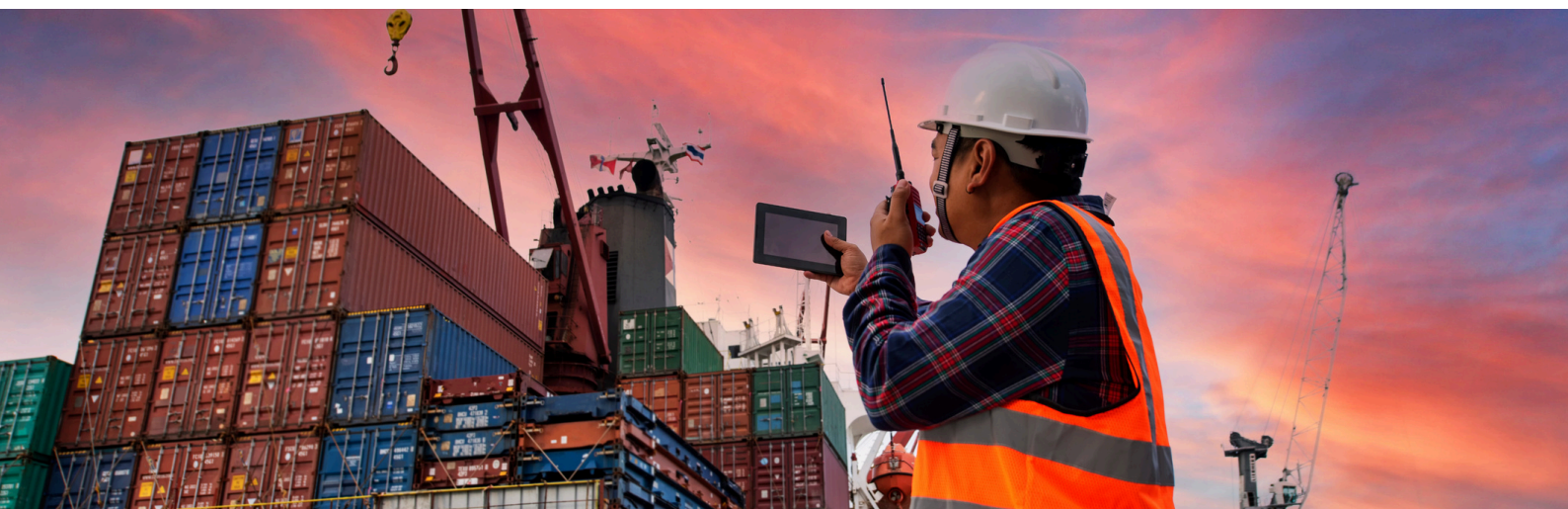

## FREIGHT HANDLER

NQF 03 | 12 MONTHS

A Freight Handler professional is responsible for the movement of goods and ensures that freight is handled safely and in an efficient way. A Freight Handler receives, allocates, stores, picks, reconciles, and dispatches freight through a storage facility.

### COMMON TYPES OF FREIGHT HANDLING MACHINES

- **Forklifts:** Lift/move pallets (counterbalance, reach truck, pallet jack)
- **Cranes:** Lift heavy/oversized loads (overhead, gantry, mobile)
- **Container Handling Equipment:** Ports/terminals (reach stacker, straddle carrier, empty container handler)

### TRANSPORT CLERK

A Transport Clerk compiles and keeps records of operational aspects and coordinates the timing of the movement and supply of freight (goods and livestock) and passengers from origin to destination in terms of stakeholder requirements.

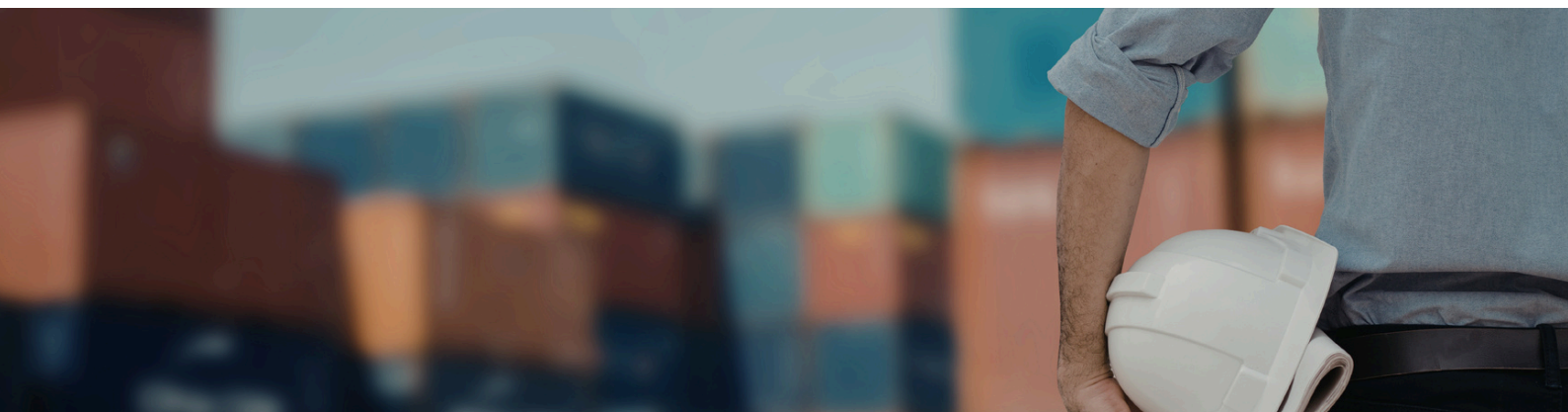
It involves the movement of all goods and materials from raw material stages, through the manufacturing process, to the delivery of finished products and their disposal. It also deals with the routing and/or scheduling of freight and passengers, using all transport modes and related activities.

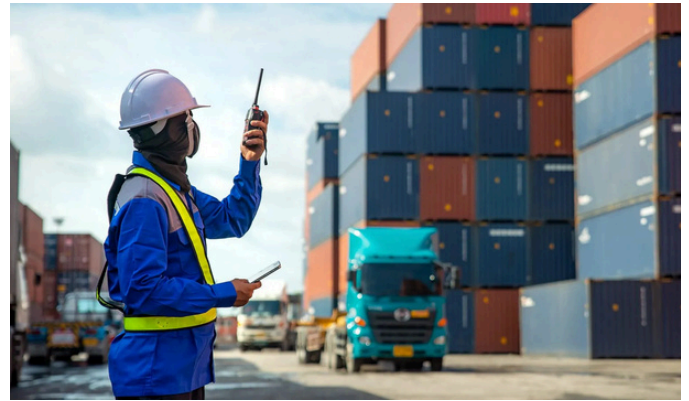


### CLEARING & FORWARDING AGENT

A Clearing and Forwarding Agent is responsible for customs clearing procedures, ensure that insurance, export/import licenses, and other formalities are in place to facilitate the movement of cargo both internationally and locally, and to ensure compliance with current legislation.

All learners will be exposed to the following software systems as part of the programme:

Cargowise, EasyClear, Muvyr.

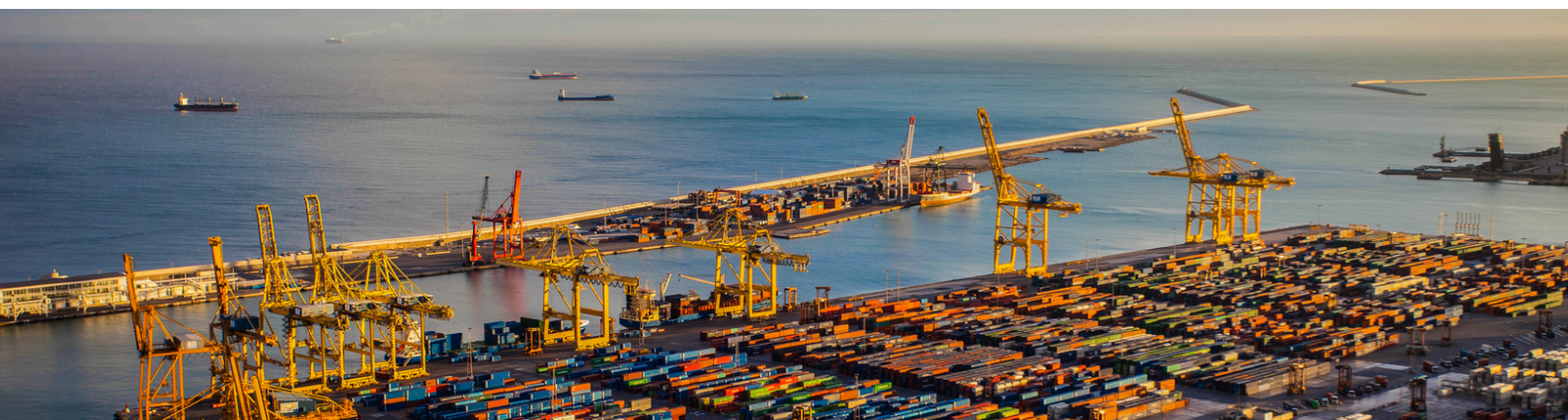

### SHIPPING AGENT

Shipping Agents are responsible for the planning for the port call of a ship and managing its port operations and post departure activities. In simple terms, this refers to the receiving and dispatch of a ship at a port.

The role of a shipping agent is vital to ensure that vessels are expedited through our ports, by liaising with the various service suppliers and authorities for scheduling and delivery of goods and services to the vessel.

The Shipping Agent liaises and processes transactions of a ship or cargo on behalf of the ship owners, ship managers and ship charterers.

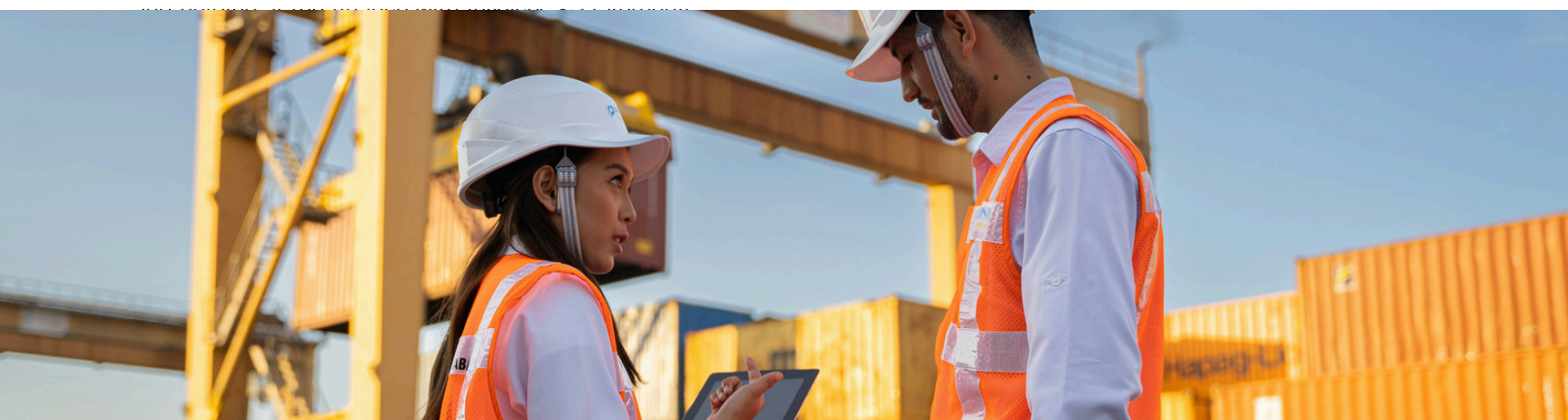

This qualification seeks to establish advanced knowledge and practical skills in Supply Chain Management and to provide the necessary competencies for individuals entering the field, as well as those with existing experience who wish to progress into management roles. It equips learners with the ability to develop operational plans, implement supply chain strategies, and monitor performance to ensure effective service delivery.

It prepares individuals to develop integrated supply chain strategies, review policies, and monitor performance to ensure effective and sustainable operations.

## CARGOWISE WORKSHOP

The CargoWise workshop provides learners with a practical introduction to using the CargoWise system in the maritime and logistics environment. The session covers system navigation, shipment creation, documentation, and basic freight forwarding workflows. Learners gain insight into how CargoWise is used to manage imports, exports, tracking, and compliance, linking classroom theory to real-world industry operations.

## INCOTERMS WORKSHOP

This training workshop assists the participant in demonstrating knowledge about International Commercial Terms (INCOTERMS), the roles and responsibilities regarding carriage, costs and risks and making recommendations regarding the usage of international commercial terms.

The course will cover updates from the 2010 to 2020 Incoterms, addressing risks, costs and responsibilities of importer and exporter, with an emphasis on the impact for the freight forwarders (operating both on and behalf of either the importer or exporter).
